



Pirate's Regatta RULES

Pirate Ship Regulations

- The Pirate Ship must be carried by Captain and Crew to the starting area.
- Only the Captain will be allowed sail the ship.
- Pirate Ship must be made with the supplies provided, including, but not limited to cardboard, duct tape, shower curtain liner, fabric, and markers.
- No use of fasteners, sealers or any other materials will be allowed.
- Trading materials is allowed between teams.
- Pirate Ship must be no longer than 6 feet and no wider than 3 feet.
- Pontoons are not Pirate Ships. Participants must build a Pirate Ship to participate.

Race Rules

- Construction Zone
 - Participants will have building materials at the Gaylord Palms Resort, lawn area, by 5 pm on the event date. Captain and Crew will have a total of 3 hours to construct their Pirate Ship. Unauthorized materials will result in disqualification.
- Means of Propulsion
 - Hand paddling is recommended.
 - Use of feet in the water to kick will result in disqualification.
 - No taping of hands.
 - No using the pool edge to propel the Pirate Ship.
- Horseplay
 - No holding on to other Pirate Ships causing them to take on water or preventing them from going forward.



- Additional Rules
 - Participants who have been disqualified are to remove their Pirate Ships from the water immediately upon being notified of disqualification.
 - Participants are to get out of the pool immediately after completion of the race and carry their Pirate Ship from the pool area.
 - All participants entering the pool must wear appropriate swimming attire.
 - All participants are required to remove the remains of their Pirate Ship from the pool area immediately after their race. Pirate Ships are not to be left in the water to see how long they will float.
 - Participants waive their right to sue due to drowning. Participate at your own risk.

Race Procedures

- Race will start at designated end of the pool.
- Participants will set their Pirate Ships in the water once the whistle blows and board.
- Participants are to paddle only down to the other end of the pool, touch the side of the pool and return to finish at the starting end.
 - Participants who fail to touch the side of the pool at the shallow end will be disqualified.
- Participants are not allowed to travel down the side of the pool using the edge of the pool to propel the Pirate Ship.
 - Using the edge of the pool to propel the Pirate Ship will result in disqualification.
- If enough Pirate Ships are present, multiple heats will be run.
